Secursat is a company specialising in the development of complex technological solutions for risk management and in operational and strategic security consulting services. Founded in 2013 in the Asti area, the company offers a flexible, technological, inclusive and sustainable service model, supporting a gradual organisational path for corporate security towards technology-based models and moving beyond traditional "labour intensive" and "on-site maintenance" models through a virtuous use of the technology network. Secursat's vision is to place security within a broader context of business and process governance, transforming the market's traditional approaches.

The company is based in Asti and Milan and operates throughout Italy through a network of certified partners.

The model

Secursat's organisational model is structured around three closely integrated business units:

1. *Security Consulting*: a team of experts and UNI 10459:2017 certified Security Managers who handle risk analysis (Risk Assessment), data analysis, process standardisation and support in the design of complex systems to mitigate corporate vulnerabilities, using their expertise as a driver for model change and business development.
2. *Monitoring - Techno Hub*: an operational structure centred on the two SOC's (Asti and Milan). It manages the remote monitoring of technologies and events, ticket/incident management and remote maintenance to rationalise costs, optimise mobility, rationalise the recovery of hardware and technologies, and integrate data collection through advanced dashboards with machine learning and AI solutions.
3. *Technical Support (System Integration)*: a team of in-house technicians and a national network of partners for the design and implementation of integrated and scalable system installations, with connectivity solutions for the management of certified network infrastructures dedicated to security.

Our mission is to spread the strategic value of security for communities, companies and organisations, overturning the traditional concept of security and redesigning it within a broader concept of business protection and process governance.

The technology infrastructure of the two centralised Security Operation Centers (SOCs) makes it possible to reduce on-site interventions, optimise repetitive activities and operate in line with disaster recovery logic, ensuring business continuity. In addition, the choice to design modular, scalable systems based on open protocols extends the life cycle of devices, significantly reducing technological waste. As evidence of the solidity of these practices, Secursat has also obtained ISO 14001:2015 certification for environmental management and the EcoVadis qualification, a prestigious recognition of the good environmental and social practices adopted.
